Douglas Alger develops architecture roadmaps, solutions and policies for the physical infrastructure of Cisco's Data Centers around the world. He has participated in more than 80 major Data Center projects, from all-new construction to substantially retrofitting existing facilities, and is the author of two Data Center design books.

Ron Hughes has been involved in the design, operation, and construction of data centers for over twenty years. As owner of California Data Center Design Group, Mr. Hughes has supervised the design of over 2,000,000 square feet of state-of-the-art data centers. CDCDG is recognized as one of the leaders in data center design.

Jessica Black is a green building and sustainability advisor as well as an expert in LEED Certification.
